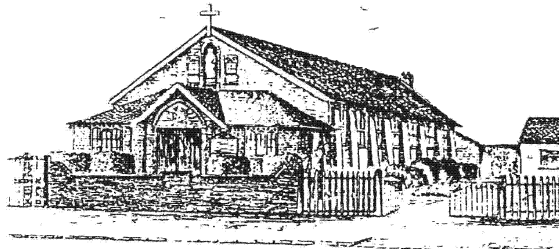

Year of Paul 27

The Acts of the Apostles finishes with the statement that Paul was under house arrest in Rome but does not give an account of his martyrdom. Paul was eventually beheaded on the orders of the Emperor Nero. According to tradition, his severed head bounced three times along the ground, a fountain springing up in each place. The abbey of Tre Fontane [three springs] is built on the site and the springs still flow today. St Paul's body was buried nearby; his followers erected a monument over the grave which the Emperor Constantine replaced with St Paul's Basilica – St Paul's Outside the Walls..

FR JOHN MACK RIP

Fr John was a native of Newcastle upon Tyne and studied for the priesthood at Campion House, Osterley and St Sulpice, Paris, France. He was ordained on 1st July 1962 and was appointed as an Assistant Priest to Woodseats, Sheffield. He then moved to Holy Trinity, Newark in 1966 where he stayed until 1970 when he was appointed to Holy Souls, Scunthorpe, also as an Assistant Priest. In 1974 he became the Parish Priest at St Charles, Measham where he spent 4 years until his appointment to St Joseph's, Staveley in 1978. In 1982 Fr John's final appointment was as Parish Priest of St Hugh's, Borrowash, Derbyshire, and remained there as Parish Priest until his death on 28th May after a period of ill-health.. Fr John died after 46 years as a priest for the Diocese of Nottingham at the age of 81. May he rest in peace.
