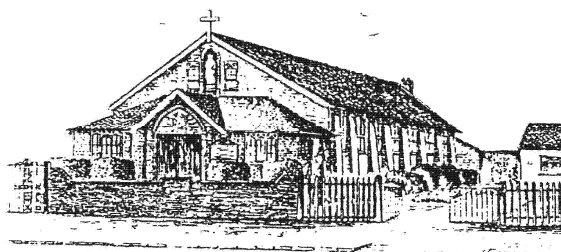

SEA SUNDAY - TODAY

The Apostleship of the Sea is the official maritime agency and outreach to international seafarers of the Catholic Church in Great Britain. This Sunday 12th July is Sea Sunday. We pray for the seafarers and their families, for the work of the Apostleship of the Sea (AOS) and for the port chaplains and volunteer helpers who provide pastoral and practical help for seafarers and their families. Seafarers are commonly

recruited from poorer countries where wages are lower. They work in difficult and often dangerous conditions suffering from loneliness, spiritual deprivation and even exploitation as they transport the goods we use and consume every day.

Sea Sunday is our chance to help AOS, on behalf of the British Catholic community, make a real difference to the lives of seafarers. Year for Priests

Pope Benedict XVI has called the whole Church to celebrate a Year for Priests beginning on 19th June 2009, the Feast of the Sacred Heart.

His purpose for this year is to encourage priests in their "striving for spiritual perfection on which, above all, depends the effectiveness of their ministry" and to highlight "the importance of the priest's role and mission in the Church and in contemporary society".

To do this the Holy Father calls us to a renewed focus on the centrality of Christ in our lives and in the Church and that "brings with it the correct appreciation of the ministerial priesthood, without which there would be neither the Eucharist, nor even the mission nor the Church herself". ***Please keep all priests in your thoughts and prayers during this year***
