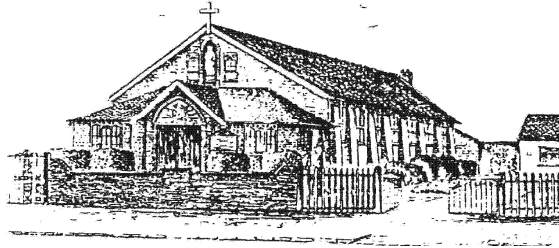

ORDINATION

Please pray for Michael Williams who will be ordained a priest on Saturday 26th June at Holy Spirit, West Bridgford, Nottingham. Through the grace of the sacrament of Priesthood, may be consecrated by the Holy Spirit and empowered to serve God and his people through his ministry in Nottingham Diocese. It is always a great joy with thanksgiving for all the diocese at the ordination of new priest. As Bishop Malcolm ordains Michael he also celebrates the anniversary of his own ordination in 1982.

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

As previously announced Bishop Malcolm has agreed to come to the parish to confer the Sacrament of Confirmation during the Autumn Term on **Monday 11th October**. **Candidates should be aged 11 and at secondary school by the end of this year.** Any young person who is eligible to be confirmed can now get a form and register. **Please ask for a form and complete and return it by next Sunday 27th June.** We will have an enrolment service during Mass on **Sunday 4th July**. There will be a meeting of all candidates the week before the enrolment. The new Catechism of the Catholic Church states: *“Every baptized person not yet confirmed can and should receive the sacrament of Confirmation. Since Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist form a unity, it follows that the faithful are obliged to receive this sacrament at the appropriate time, for without Confirmation and Eucharist, Baptism is certainly valid and efficacious, but Christian initiation remains incomplete.”* (CCC 1306)

I encourage our young people to receive the sacrament of Confirmation which involves a special giving of the Holy Spirit which seals, strengthens, confirms and perfects what was already given in Baptism and completes the full Christian initiation. Parents and godparents, please advise and encourage them to bring to completion what was begun in baptism. Please keep all our young people in your prayers during this time of preparation. Thank you.

The Papal Visit

Fr David Cain the Diocesan liaison for the Pope’s visit has sent this

email – “officials from Rome, the Bishops Conference and the UK Government will be meeting in the week beginning Monday 21st June.

After this time we will have concrete plans on which to prepare for what will be happening and I will try to keep you up to date.”

An outline of what will be happening during the visit, though this is a provisional programme and may be changed.

Thursday 16 September

Arrival at Edinburgh Airport; meeting with the Queen at Holyroodhouse; Mass at Bellahouston Park, Glasgow and then to London.

Friday 17 September

Prayer with Religious and a celebration of Catholic Education at St Mary’s, Strawberry Hill; meeting with other Faith leaders at Strawberry Hill; meeting with Archbishop of Canterbury at Lambeth Palace; televised address at Westminster Hall; Evening Prayer at Westminster Abbey.

Saturday 18 September

Mass in Westminster Cathedral; pastoral visit to St Peter’s Home for the Elderly, Vauxhall; drive through central London and Prayer Vigil in Hyde Park.

Sunday 19 September:

Beatification Mass at Coventry Airport; lunch with the Bishops at Oscott; meeting with the Bishops at Oscott; departure for Rome from Birmingham International Airport.

INVOCATION 2010

This will be held in the grounds of St Mary’s College, Oscott in Sutton Coldfield, near Birmingham from the 2nd-4th July. It is a national festival made up of 2 different events:

Day 1 Friday 2nd July – Diocesan Schools Conference. “The Role of School Leadership in Fostering a Culture of Vocation” for Head Teachers and Chaplains.

Day 2&3 3rd & 4th July Weekend – National Festival for Young People. For young men and women aged 16-35, who are looking to deepen their relationship with Christ, discern God’s will for their lives and at least be open to the possibility of priesthood or consecrated life.

A unique event in that it is the first time a national gathering of School Leaders coming together to focus on the role of leadership in fostering vocations and the first time that young people will gather nationally with a focus explicitly on vocational discernment and the bringing together most of the seminarians of England and Wales.
